13.4 Development of Student Dissemination Network

The student dissemination network is based on contacts to students from all disciplines of the Aqua-TNET domain throughout Europe. All individuals in this contact list voluntarily agreed to be subscribed to at least one information service provided by the EAS-SG, the EAS or the Aqua-TNET-project.

47 subscribers got 5 newsletters and announcements from eas_studentgroup@aquaculture.cc mail address between December, 2007 – December, 2008. In January, 2009 the new website was launched (<http://eassg.org/>) and the mailing list comprised 76 members (out of which 4 email addresses failed). Up to January, 2010 a number of 4 newsletters and communications were sent out to the network.

The student dissemination network is rounded off by the use of a social network community (facebook, www.facebook.com) with a number of 225 members from all over the world that joined a social network group moderated by representatives of WP13.

EAS - Student Group had 24 members in 2009 from 13 countries which decreased compared to last few years.
